

English Islands Clinches Top Prize at Sold-Out LevelUP Pitch Competition at the Toronto Stock Exchange

Innovation Cluster's Signature Accelerator Showcases the Next Wave of Ontario's Tech Founders

PETERBOROUGH, ON — October 31, 2025 — The Innovation Cluster — Peterborough and the Kawarthas ("Innovation Cluster") proudly announced English Islands as the grand prize winner of the LevelUP Pitch Competition, taking home the \$10,000 award after an electrifying, sold-out event held at the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX).

The evening marked a milestone for Peterborough's innovation community, as founders from across the eastern and southern province pitched their ventures before investors on one of the country's most iconic business stages.

The showcase capped off the **Innovation Cluster's intensive 12-week LevelUP Accelerator**, a program designed to help post-MVP (Minimum Viable Product) tech startups accelerate commercialization and understand how to achieve repeatable revenue.

English Islands, founded by Erica Derrickson,, impressed the judges with its personalized curriculum-aligned literacy tutoring platform.

"Pitching on the TSX stage was a surreal experience. LevelUP pushed us to refine our strategy, strengthen our business model, and get investor-ready in ways we couldn't have imagined."

Now in its **second year**, the LevelUP Accelerator continues to attract high-calibre founders from across Ontario, reflecting the growing momentum of tech

entrepreneurship in both rural and urban areas and significantly shaping the future of the tech community.
